The total number of visitors for the year to date is 4,987,803 which is 2% up on the previous year.

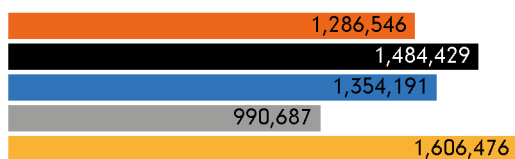
The total number of visitors to Chester in month commencing 2 April 2023 was 1,286,546.

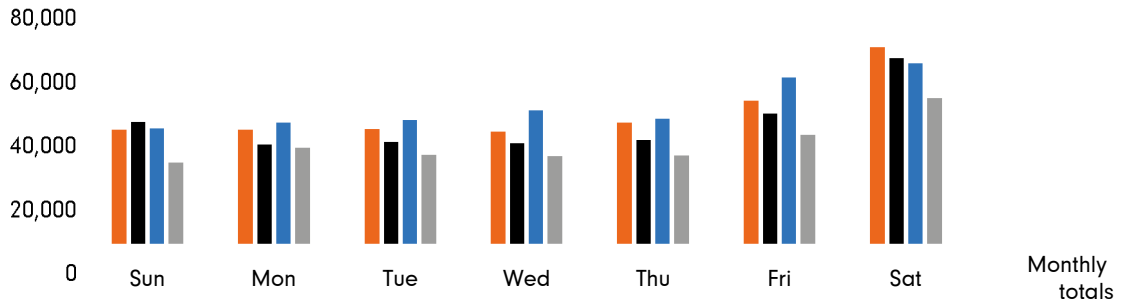

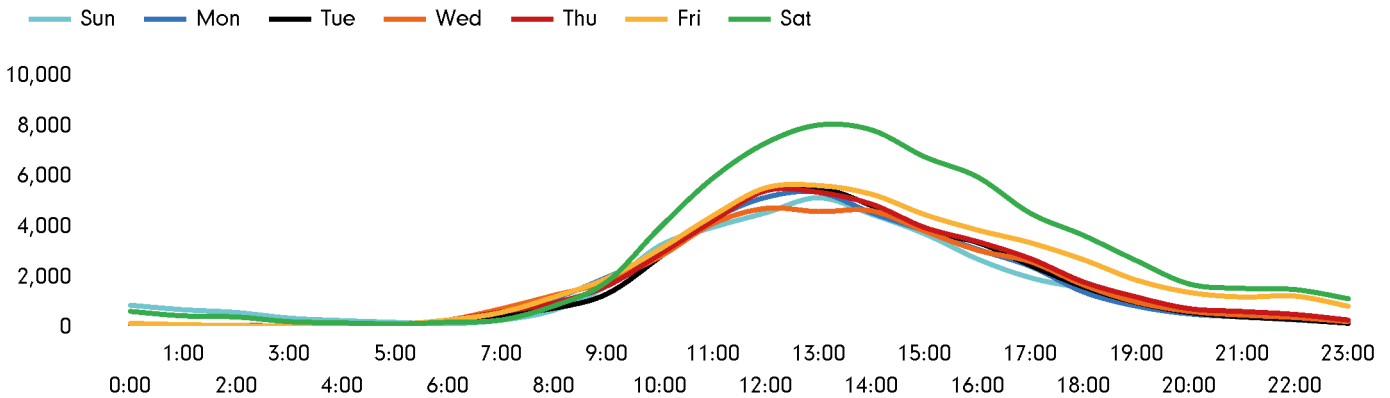

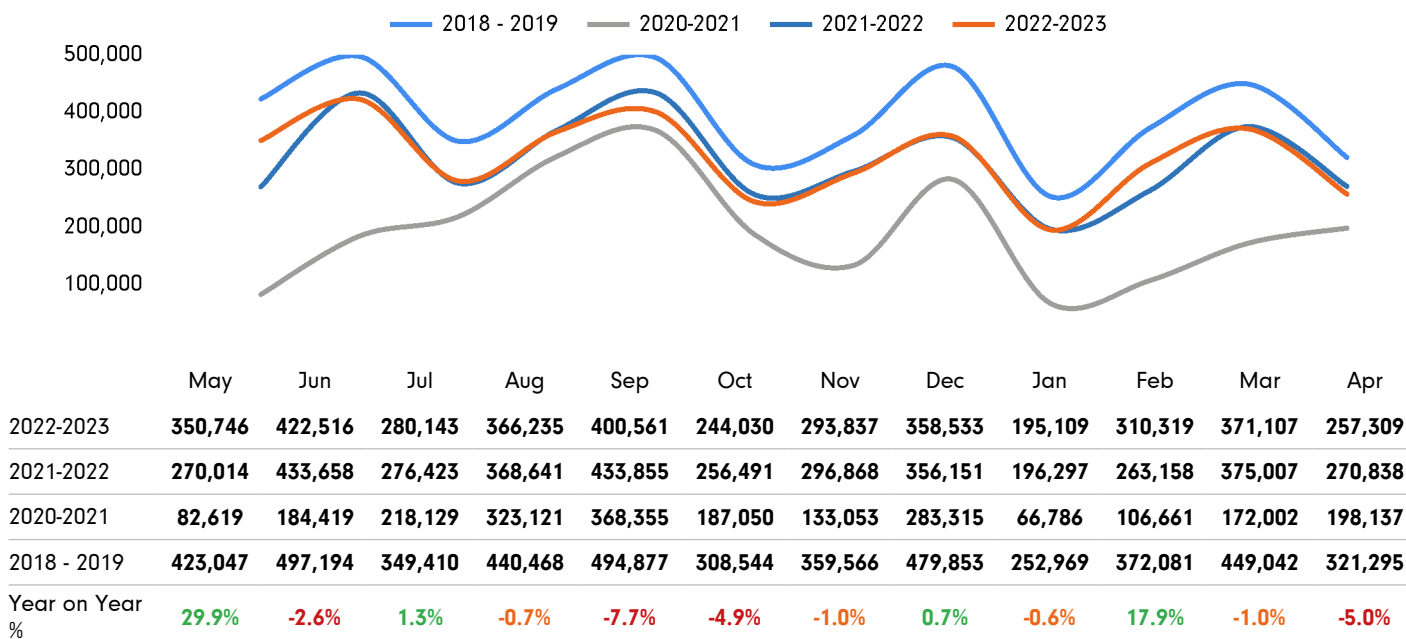
## Footfall by hour

## Footfall - rolling 12 months

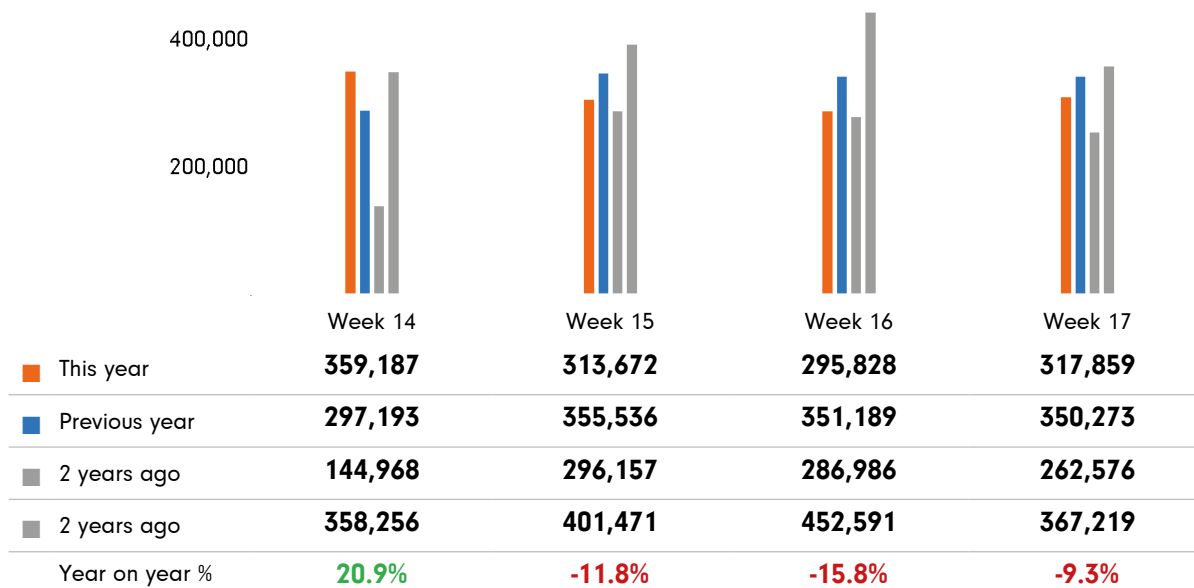

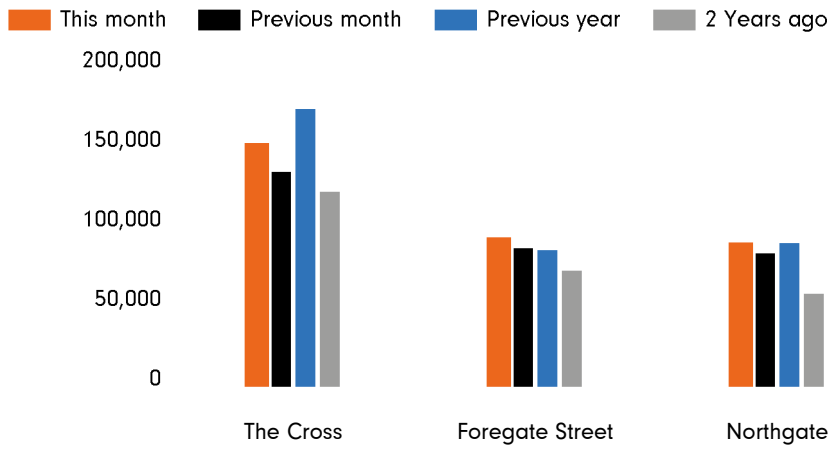
## Footfall by week of month

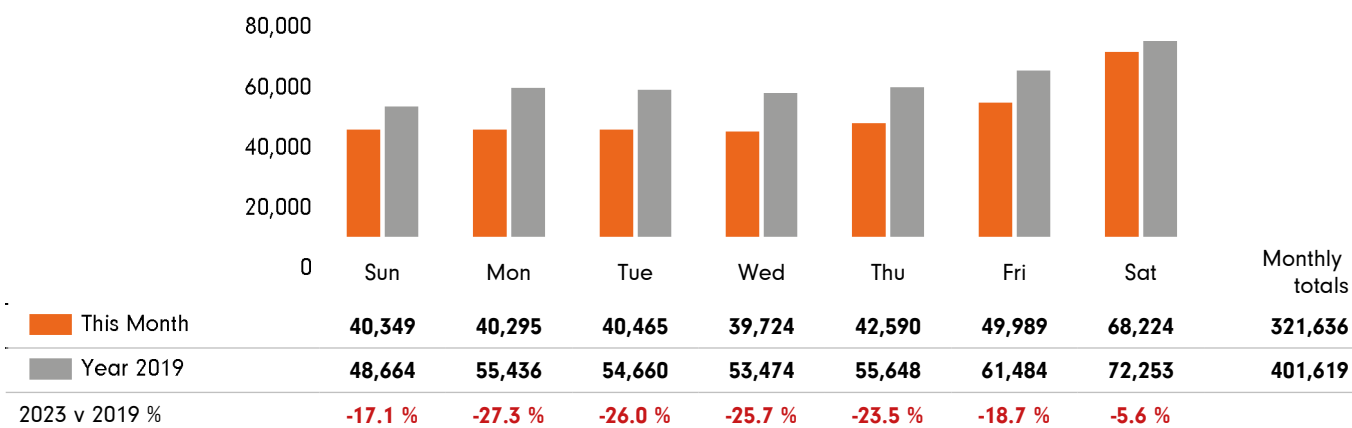

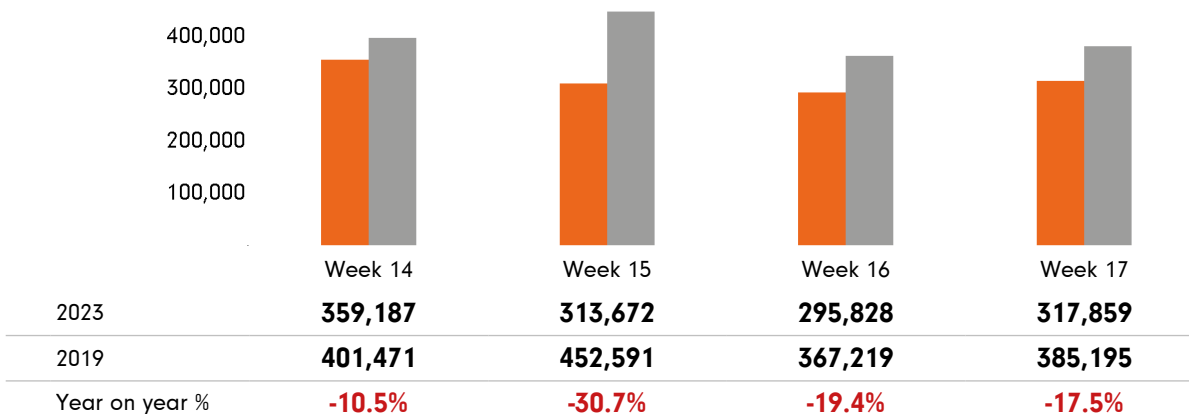
