This month saw CH1ChesterBID venture into unchartered territory and host its very first **CH1 Chester Comedy Festival**.

After nearly 12 months of planning and development, the CH1 Chester Comedy Festival saw the BID bring a host of top comic talent from television and radio to the city for a week-long celebration of everything funny.

After securing Purple Flag status earlier in the year, showcasing those businesses operating after 5pm and supporting the city's evening economy was the main driver for organising the festival.

With a brief to make the festival as 'Chester' as possible, events took place in our pubs, restaurants and iconic venues such as Chester Cathedral and The Chester Grosvenor Hotel.

The **overwhelming success** of the festival has demonstrated that there is an appetite amongst businesses and the public for such events in the city, which lays the foundations for future evening initiatives in 2019 and beyond.

BUSKING IN THE CITY CENTRE

Busking can help create a vibrant, exciting and cosmopolitan atmosphere, increasing footfall and dwell time. Chester has a thriving local busker scene and during the summer attracts buskers from around the globe.

Most buskers in Chester recognise that they can impact nearby businesses if they play too loudly and will adjust the volume if requested. The Council's Guide to Busking in Chester encourages buskers and businesses to talk to each other to try to come to an amicable arrangement that satisfies both parties.

Unfortunately, there are a small number of buskers who seem to be unwilling to turn the volume down and this is having a detrimental impact on businesses close to popular busking pitches, particularly at The Cross and on Eastgate Street.

City Centre Manager, Nick White, recently met with businesses on Eastgate Street and then with Council Officers to make an agreement.

THE AGREEMENT

- 1 The Council's Regulatory Services team will speak to all buskers, advising them on the conditions of the code of practice, emphasising the impact that excessive volume can have on neighbouring businesses and that they must not stay longer than two hours in any location.
- 2 The Council has written to the Bagpipe player advising that, due to her impact on nearby businesses, she should not play in a single location for more than 30 minutes. After 30 minutes she must move streets and not return to a location within 2 hours.
- 3 The Councils 'Guide to Busking in Chester' has been revised with a simplified reporting process. If you are unable to resolve an issue by speaking to the busker, and have a co-sign radio, you can call the Councils CCTV Control Room and they will request that a Council Officer attend. Alternatively, you can email regulatoryservices@cheshirewestandchester.gov.uk with details of the incident.
