Recently further actions have been announced:

- The new Bounce Back Loans scheme, announced by the Chancellor today, will allow businesses to borrow between £2,000 and £50,000 and access the cash within days. Loans will be interest free for the first 12 months, and from Monday 4 May, businesses can apply online through a short and simple form. [Find out more here.](#)
- Deal reached with Saudi Arabia, Bahrain, Morocco and Tunisia to [accept digital origin of good certificates](#) on UK exports.
- DIT has secured an agreement with China to allow UK businesses to [continue to export food products](#) during the pandemic.
